Dr. Juan L Salgado is from San Juan, Puerto Rico. Graduated from the Universidad Central del Caribe, School of Medicine in Puerto Rico in 1985. He completed his residency in OB/GYN at the Caguas Regional Hospital, Caguas, PR in 1989. Board certified in OB-GYN and Minimally Invasive Surgery by the American Board of OB-GYN. He is an international speaker in endometriosis and laparoscopy. His main work is in preoperative Staging of Endometriosis with transvaginal ultrasound and operative laparoscopy for deep infiltrating endometriosis.

Dr. Salgado is Professor in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology and Clinical curriculum director of the Fourth year at the Universidad Central del Caribe School of Medicine in Bayamon Puerto Rico. Is a member of the Board of Trustees of the Society of Laparoscopy and Robotic surgeons.

Dr Salgado was trained in Sao Paulo Brazil with Dr. Mauricio Abrao, in endometriosis and mapping of endometriosis with transvaginal ultrasound in 2010. His practice was the first center in USA and the Caribbean to establish and to perform the mapping of endometriotic lesions as a preoperative tool for planning the strategies of his endometriosis surgeries.

His main goal is to do a complete excision surgery after preoperative mapping of lesions to prevent persistence of the disease. His theory is: " It is not recurrence, rather, it is persistence of the disease due to incomplete surgery because the patient did not have a complete preoperative evaluation."
