She specializes in reduced site gynecologic laparoscopic techniques and vaginal re-enhancement. She is focused with single-site laparoscopic surgery for gynecology procedures and Aesthetic Gynecology. Dr. Ybanez-Morano continues to practice high-risk Obstetrics. A few years ago, she has served President for SLS (The Society of Laparoscopic and Robotic Surgeons) in 2020. She has served SLS for over 10 years in various roles.

Dr. Ybanez-Morano is doubly boarded with the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists and the American College of Physician Executives (aka the American Association of Physician Leaders.) She maintains numerous academic positions. She received adjunct faculty appointments with the West Virginia School of Osteopathic Medicine, West Liberty University and West Virginia University School of Medicine.
