- No embedded media files are permitted.
- Keep in mind that the **Summary** page (first page in template) is a quick glance of the data contained in the entire ePoster and this slide should briefly summarize:
 - 1) Background and Objectives.
 - 2) Study Design and Methods.
 - 3) Results and Conclusion.You can expand on items 1-4 above on the remaining pages in the template.
- **The slides you create will appear as submitted. It is imperative that you review each slide in the template before uploading your ePoster. ePosters submitted with altered formats will not be accepted.**

When reviewing your slides, specifically look for:

- 1) Typographical errors,
 - 2) Arial font size 28 on all slides,
 - 3) Clear and labeled images (image labels must be a minimum of Arial font size 14),
 - 4) Easy to follow layout with white space and spacing between paragraphs
 - 5) No background color
- Save your completed template to a folder on your computer.
 - Upload your ePoster to the Abstract Submission Form.
